Do you utilize the Township Mini Dump?

Union Township TAX BILLS are being mailed the week of JULY 16. Inside the tax bill envelope is a bright yellow paper – our new Township Directory and Mini Dump Permit.

The new Mini Dump Permit portion looks like this:

CUT AND RETAIN IN VEHICLE – THIS IS YOUR 2012-2013 DUMPSTER PERMIT

Property Owner Address _____ Block / Lot _____

Beginning September 1, 2012, **no vehicle will be admitted** to the mini dump without this paper permit.

Dumpster Hours: First and Third Saturdays of Each Month, 8am – 12pm (OR UNTIL FULL). Please show this permit to the dumpster attendant and follow the directions of the attendant or person in charge.

The following materials are **prohibited** and no person shall deposit or place any such material(s) in or about the Municipal dumpster or on Municipal property: 1) Construction/ demolition material; 2) Commercial/industrial establishment material; 3) Liquid waste; 4) Hazardous, toxic, flammable or explosive material; 5) Dirt, sand, rock, cement, concrete, blacktop or similar material; 6) Lumber or railroad ties; 7) Auto frames, bodies or parts; 8) Tires 9) Tree stumps, leaves, limbs or other vegetation; 10) Cardboard, paper, or other recyclables; 11) Household garbage, refuse or trash; 12) Freon containing device unless accompanied by receipt from Clerk's Office.

Beginning September, 2012, no one will be allowed to use the Mini Dump without this new paper permit. Please watch for the permit in your mail, fill it out with your address and remember to bring it with you for all Mini Dump visits. If you rent your home, obtain the Mini Dump permit for your home from the property owner.

Cartage fees are expensive! We need to insure that ONLY Union Residents, who pay for this service through their property taxes, use the Mini Dump. We appreciate your cooperation.
