BOARD OF HEALTH ORDINANCE NO. 1-2020

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING “AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE ADOPTION REGULATIONS PROVIDING STANDARDS FOR THE LOCATION, DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION, INSTALLATION, ALTERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF INDIVIDUAL SUBSURFACE SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEMS IN THE TOWNSHIP OF UNION, COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY” REGARDING WITNESSING FEES FOR VARIOUS TESTS (AMENDMENT NO. 3)

BE IT ORDAINED by the **Board of Health of the Township of Union**, in Hunterdon County, New Jersey that the ordinance entitled “AN ORDINANCE ADOPTION REGULATIONS PROVIDING STANDARDS FOR THE LOCATION, DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION, INSTALLATION, ALTERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF INDIVIDUAL SUBSURFACE SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEMS IN THE TOWNSHIP OF UNION, COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY,” as previously amended by Ordinance No. 93-8, is hereby further amended as follows:

1. Section 8 regarding fees and charges amended. Section 8 is hereby amended to read as follows (new text is underlined thus; deleted text is struck through and in brackets[~~thus~~):

SECTION 8. The following fees and charges are herewith established:

(a) For the filing of an application and plans to locate and construct an individual sewage disposal system, plan review, site inspection, issuance of permit and installation inspection, or as per current Hunterdon County Freeholder Resolution Schedule, to be collected by the Hunterdon County Health Department	\$200.00
(b) For the filing of an application and plans for a permit to alter an existing individual sewage disposal system and issue said permit, or do as per current Hunterdon County Freeholder Resolution Schedule, to be collected by the Hunterdon County Health Department	\$100.00
(c) For filing an application for repair, or as per current Hunterdon County Freeholder Resolution Schedule, to be collected by the Hunterdon County Health Department	\$ 50.00
(d) Application renewal fee, or as per current Hunterdon County Freeholder Resolution Schedule, to be collected by the Hunterdon County Health Department (See Section 7)	\$ 50.00

(e) To witness percolation tests, pit bailing, basin flooding, soil borings or other approved testing, per day or part thereof	[\$425.00 \$ 350.00]
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2. Repealer. All ordinances and resolutions or parts thereof inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

3. Severability. If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged by the courts to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of this ordinance shall be valid and enforceable.

4. Effective date. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 26:3-69, this ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after the date of the first publication as provided by law.

5. Short title. The short title of this ordinance shall be Amendment No. 3 to the Union Township Individual Subsurface Sewage Disposal Ordinance.
